Please bring your insurance card and a list of current medications with you when you visit the Urologic Center. We urge you to continue to obtain your general medical care with your physician. We will, of course, keep your regular doctor advised on your urologic care.

Please check in with the receptionist before and after you visit one of our physicians. The secretary will make any necessary appointments for you and will schedule any tests or procedures.



BILLING PROCEDURES

Because we are a private practice dedicated to providing you with high quality, cost-effective urologic care, we urge you to recognize that our physician's bill reflects an agreement between you and your doctor. You are responsible for full payment of your bill regardless of the state of your insurance claim.

All charges are due and payable at the time you receive our services, and payment is requested on the day of your visit. Your cooperation helps us keep expenses to a minimum, and all our patients can benefit by keeping the cost of medical care as low as possible. Our staff will be happy to talk with you about our fees. We will help you file any insurance forms required.

Most medical insurance requires pre-authorization on many procedures. We urge you to review the requirements of your insurance! Second opinions may be required before some procedures are performed.

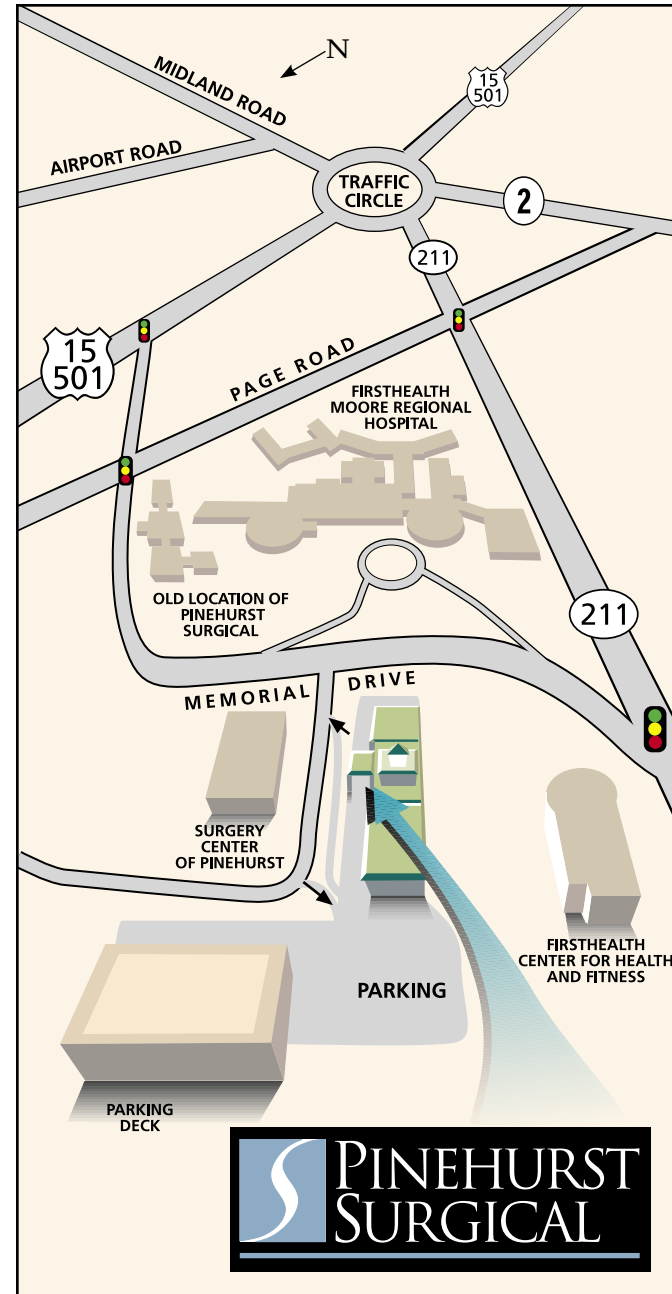

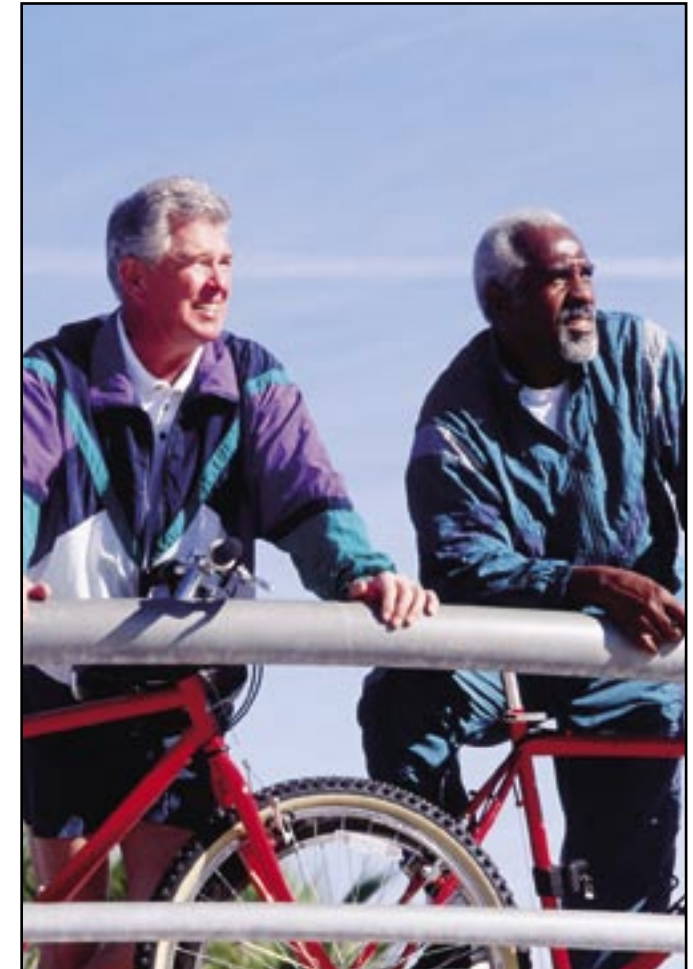
OUR LOCATION
